

Did you know that any member of the staff of the Commission has a 24-hour accident insurance cover?

Dear Colleagues,

Whether you are an official or a member of the temporary or contract staff, you are covered 24 hours a day, wherever you are throughout the world, for any accident^[2] occurring during or even outside working hours.

Your insurance therefore covers:

- travel to and from work,
- sports and other leisure activities, except participation in motorised competitions and high-risk sports,
- accidents of any sort in your private or family life (gardening, odd jobs around the house etc.),
- poisoning, bites of animals or of stings of insects.

Once an accident is recognised to have occurred, the victim is entitled not only to 100 % reimbursement of all medical expenses incurred, but also to monetary compensation where some degree of post-injury invalidity is recognised.

If you suffer an accident, you must:

- fill in an <u>'accident report' form</u> (the section entitled 'Medical certificate Initial accident report' must be completed by a doctor (<u>https://myintracomm.ec.europa.eu/staff/Documents/health/accident-report-en.pdf</u>)
- date, sign and send it to PMO within 10 days of the accident (except in cases of *force majeure*);
