

Heat wave is coming...

Luxembourg, 24 June 2019

The weather announces a heat wave on Luxembourg for this week.

The USF Luxembourg reminds you of the advice of preventions stated by the European Commission on the subject:

Where the temperature in the workplace is found to be above or below the limits laid down in the general occupational health and safety regulations (for offices, this means no more than 30°C and no less than 20°C), the Directors-General of the affected staff should take all appropriate measures to remedy the situation without delay.

Where no remedy is possible, members of staff are entitled to ask the CSHT Secretariat to take immediate action.'

That's why Union Syndicale Fédérale Luxembourg invites management to make suitable arrangements, notably as regards working hours, and even if necessary as regards the physical presence of the staff concerned (officials, other agents and other staff).

USF Luxembourg advices to colleagues the following measures:

- Measure the temperature in your office.
- Adapt your working hours with your hierarchy or request a teleworking during this difficult period.
- If possible, work in air-conditioned areas of the building (restaurants, unused conference rooms, etc.).
- If you feel unwell, call the medical service (12) immediately.
